Change to afternoon procedures.

One of the adjustments we made last year due to COVID was the 'soft finish' to the school day at 2:50pm. The official finish to the school day always remained 3:00pm, however as we had fewer children catching the bus and in order to disperse the higher number of parents picking up, we made this temporary arrangement. As things have now settled, more students are catching the bus again and restrictions have eased, we will go back to the official finish time of 3:00pm from next Monday 3rd May. This means that the gates will open at 2:50pm and teachers will begin bringing students out from 2:55pm -3:00pm. Children who remain after 3:00pm will be supervised by the teachers then brought to the hall for parent pick up.

Parents are asked to wait in the courtyard areas (where the artificial grass is).

Please do not wait on or near the verandahs nor collect the students directly from the classroom.

Social distancing protocols still apply.


Specialist Reports

We know some children attend outside interventions such as Speech Therapy and Occupation Therapy. Please remember to send in any reports or recommendations from those so that we can work together to fully support your child's learning.

Sacred Space

Catholics believe that the soul also needs to grow in the life of grace. The sacrament of Confirmation builds on the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, and Holy Communion, completing the process of initiation into the Catholic community.

Confirmation, a sacrament of initiation, establishes young adults as full-fledged members of the faith. This sacrament is called Confirmation because the faith given in Baptism is now confirmed and made strong. During your Baptism, your parents and godparents make promises to renounce Satan and believe in God and the Church on your behalf. At Confirmation, you renew those same promises, this time speaking for yourself.



During Confirmation, the focus is on the Holy Spirit, who confirmed the apostles on Pentecost and gave them courage to practice their faith. Catholics believe that the same Holy Spirit confirms Catholics during the Sacrament of Confirmation and gives them the same gifts.

Traditionally, the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude (courage), knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. These gifts are supernatural graces given to the soul. The 12 fruits of the Holy Spirit are charity, joy, peace, patience, benignity, goodness, long-suffering, mildness, faith, modesty, continency, and chastity — human qualities that can be activated by the Holy Spirit.

Our school will appear in 'Nearby Locations' if you're within 10kms of the school, or search for our school by name.


Step 4 Register your children

If you have made a purchase you can select our school from 'Previous Location'




If you're within 10 kms of the school, you can select our school from 'Nearby Locations'


